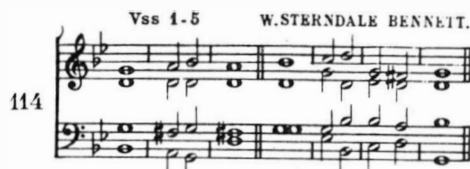
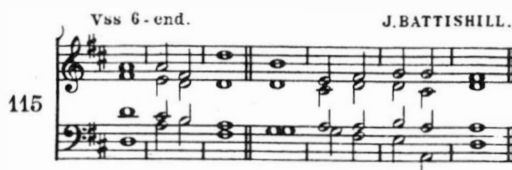


PSALM 60. *Deus, repulisti nos.*



- p* O God thou hast cast us out and scattered 'us a'broad : thou hast also been displeased, O turn thee 'unto 'us a'gain.
- 2 Thou hast moved the 'land and di'vided it : heal the 'sores thereof 'for it 'shaketh.

- 9 Who will lead me into the 'strong 'city : who will 'bring me 'into 'Edom?
- 10 Hast not thou cast us 'out O 'God : wilt not thou O 'God go 'out with our 'hosts?
- 11 O be thou our 'help in 'trouble : for 'vain is the 'help of 'man.
- 12 Through God will we 'do great 'acts : for it is he that 'shall tread 'down our 'enemies.
